We are excited you and your students will be visiting The Lacombe Corn Maze for a field trip this season. We are busy preparing exciting and educational activities that will give your students rewarding hands-on experiences with agriculture and feel it will be a very informative experience for all who attend.

Your field trip has been confirmed to begin at **11:30am** on Thursday, October 5, 2006. If there is a conflict with this day or time, please contact Rachel or Linda at (403) 782-4653 or (403) 302-1709 (info@lacombecornmaze.com) as soon as possible. As a reminder, we ask that you arrange to have one adult chaperone in attendance for every six to ten children visiting our facilities. Normal field trip rates are \$4 per student Grades K- 6 and group pricing is in effect for grades 7-12. (\$2 off general admission per person in groups of 20 or more) We accept cash, cheques, Mastercard, and Visa. When you arrive, please let us know if you will need a receipt. We have a new attraction at the maze (only the second year!) called a Jumping Pillow. This is like a giant trampoline in the ground. You can take a look at our website for pictures. There is an extra charge of \$2 per person for the pillow if everyone buys a wristband as a group (one transaction). Separately, the students can purchase the all-day wristbands for \$3.

We are located 4.8km (3m) west of Lacombe. Go 1.6 km (1m) west of the Hwy #2 overpass on Hwy # 12, then 0.8km (0.5m) south on Range Road 27-3. Watch for the signs. The maze is on the right hand side of the road. There is a field on the north side of the maze (turn right when you pull into the driveway) that serves as the parking lot. Please have your bus pull directly into the field.

Once on site, we will give a brief introduction to the maze and the agricultural principles behind it. Your students will then be divided into groups of 6-8 students and one chaperone if they are not divided already. Each group will then be allowed to go through the maze, using the passports to guide them along the correct pathway.

It is important that your students know beforehand that they must stay within sight of their chaperone while visiting the maze. We try to keep the corn looking its best for all of our visitors. Therefore, any students found to be breaking the rules (eg. wrecking corn, going off the path, etc.) will be asked to leave and not be allowed back into the maze.

Tents, fire pits, and picnic tables are available for lunch. We also have a bbq you may use but please let us know ahead of time so we can make sure we reserve it for you. We do have a concession but do not serve meals, only snacks and drinks. Restrooms are located on site.

In case of inclement weather, please call (403) 782-4653 or (403) 302-1709 or email info@lacombecornmaze.com before departing to confirm that your field trip will take place at the scheduled day and time. Those who are unable to take their tours because of weather conditions will have the option of rescheduling their field trip.
